MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

between

MOSCOW STATE FOREST UNIVERSITY

and

COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE & LIFE SCIENCES SEOUL NATIONAL UNIVERSITY

- 1. Moscow State Forest University (MSFU), Moscow, Russia, and College of Agriculture and Life Sciences (CALS), Seoul National University, Seoul, Korea, wish to promote collaboration and cooperation in the field of research and teaching focused on forestry and environment-related sciences according to this MOU.
- 2. Collaboration in the field of teaching in forestry and environment-related sciences will include exchange of the curricula and programmes for both graduate and postgraduate studies and joint development of teaching materials, exchange of professors, students and faculty staff, using both internal and external grants and financial sources.
- 3. Cooperation in the field of research will consist of exchanging information about important research activities and organising joint workshops or conferences. The MSFU and CALS agree to carry on joint research projects by additional sub-agreements between respective faculties of both universities constituting an integral part of this MOU, and to conduct scientific cooperation.
- 4. The MOU becomes effective on the date when signed by both of MSFU and CALS, and shall stay effective for an indefinite period of time.
- 5. Either MSFU or CALS may want to terminate this MOU providing the other with a written notice of its intent to terminate at least 3 months prior to the effective date of the termination.
- 6. The MSFU and CALS shall establish the full terms and conditions of their detailed agreements on joint research projects, time of their implementation, staff mobility and other forms of collaboration for individual calendar years.
- 7. The MOU has been prepared in two identical copies in English, one copy for each institution.
